

## Developing the strategic role of the CSP – key areas of work for 2010

### Prioritising:

- quality of life issues in our most disadvantaged neighbourhoods.

- latest data on child poverty, what programmes are already in place, what the potential gaps might be and where the CSP can work with partners to improve outcomes
- latest data on young people not in education, employment or training, what programmes are already in place, what the potential gaps might be and where the CSP can work with partners to improve outcomes

### Engaging with:

- partners to ensure delivery affordable housing
- GCC to ensure effective services for young people across the borough
- GCC in the production of the Local Transport Plan 3

### Keeping an overview of:

- The joint core strategy
- The civic pride scheme
- The supporting people programme

### How we will take these forward

- Shaping future commissioning arrangements with partners to start to align budgets behind our priority areas.
- Developing a programme to develop a new sustainable community strategy for 2011 onwards.
