Held on Saturday 10 October (world mental health day), at leisure@ and included various health checks, physical activities and advice. Over 50 people attended and 72% of those surveyed said that the event had fully met their personal requirements. The opportunity was also used to measure which of the priorities within the action plan are of most/least importance to the community. Healthy Eating and Emotional Health were rated the most important and Health Inequalities were rated as being the least important.
