

## Summary of the neighbourhood management proposal in the report to Cheltenham Borough Council's Cabinet on 27 October 2009

The suggested host organisations in the proposal are the 5 parish councils and 3 regeneration partnerships in Cheltenham. The proposed neighbourhood co-ordination group (NCG) areas established by the Police which they would cover are below along with the initial responses:
